HOW TO BECOME CERTIFIED

01

Complete training with Focus on Energy and a mentorship with a participating BPC.

02

Perform three mentored field inspections and a final graded field inspection.

03

Pass the RESNET's Combustion Appliance Zone (RESCAZ) simulation exam and apply for a Rating Field Inspector Identification Number (RFIIN).

WHAT IS A RATING FIELD INSPECTOR?

An individual certified by a Rating Quality Assurance Provider to conduct field inspections for home energy ratings. RFIs, under the direct supervision of certified Home Energy Raters (called BPCs in Wisconsin), may conduct inspections and necessary basic performance tests (air tightness and duct leakage) to produce a home energy rating. This certification requires the ability to identify and quantify building components and systems.



All RFI Trainees are responsible for paying their RFI Application fee.
