Proven Process for Energy Savings

A grain dryer tune-up focuses on key components to make sure the system operates efficiently. A tune-up includes:



Cleaning fans and screens.



Calibrating sensors.



Inspecting burners.



Improving control settings.

These adjustments can lead to safer farming practices, faster drying times, and energy savings, averaging **\$0.20 per acre**. From 2019 to 2022, Focus on Energy awarded **\$7,500** annually in tune-up rebates to support these improvements.
