HOW TO APPLY

FOCUS ON ENERGY® invites school and government customers to begin their electrification efforts by reducing their overall electric load. Before starting plans to convert to renewable energy and electrify buildings, focus on existing electric infrastructure and reduce your energy consumption. Make your electric reduction project happen sooner with additional rebates from Focus on Energy.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

- 1 Start by identifying your electric savings project.
- 2 Complete the attached application with the estimated savings, rebates requested, scope of work, and program impact questionnaire.
- 3 Submit completed paperwork to Focus on Energy. Once funds are allocated to this accelerator, the offering will be closed. **Funding is limited.**

REQUIREMENTS

- Customer must be a school or government.
- Project site must be served by participating Focus on Energy **utilities** and be in a **rural ZIP code**.
- Requested rebate cannot exceed 100% of total project cost.
- Retrocommissioning and renewable energy projects are not eligible.
- Projects already approved or submitted for pre-approval review by Focus on Energy are not eligible.
- Submit your funding request by February 28, 2026.
- Projects must be completed by October 31, 2026.
- All completion paperwork must be received within 60 days of installation and no later than October 31, 2026.
 - Completion paperwork will include a signed Project Completion Notice, final invoices, and acknowledgment from the Energy Advisor confirming the project has been completed.

Funding request may be denied or a counteroffer may be provided based on cost effectiveness (rebates per MMBtu saved), Focus on Energy impact, or funding availability.

TECHNOLOGY INVESTMENT FUND (TIF)

Looking for additional funding options? Consider using the TIF to provide a low- or no-interest loan up to \$600,000 with terms of up to five years. Contact your Focus on Energy Advisor to start the process.

Rebates and incentives are limited to \$300,000 per project and \$400,000 per customer per calendar year for all Focus on Energy rebates (standard and custom). Depending on the business tax classification of the payee, the entity receiving the rebate or incentive payment may receive IRS form 1099 for incentives totaling over \$600 in a calendar year.
