COMMERCIAL ENERGY ADVISOR TERRITORY MAP



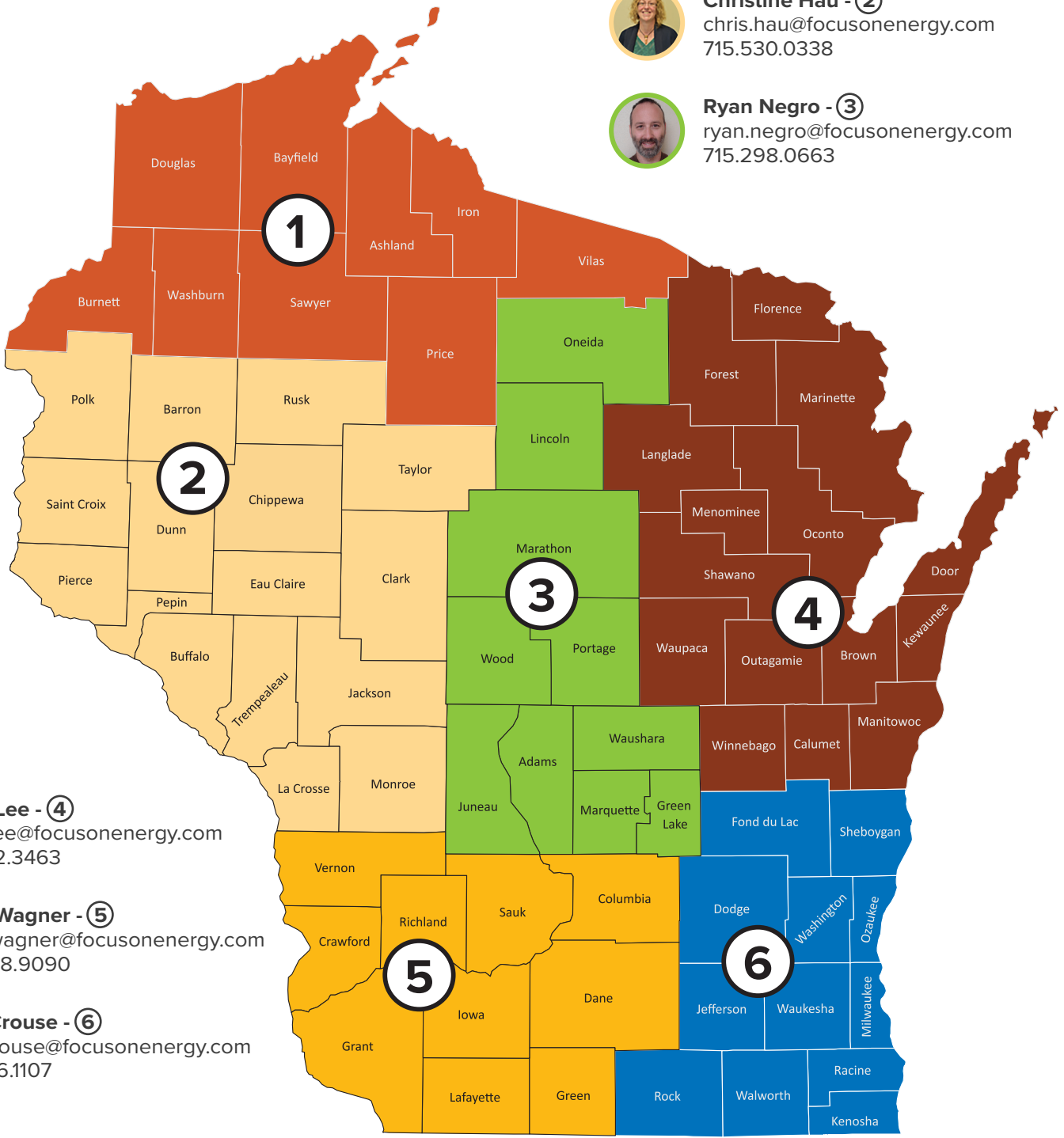
