** 80% Area Median Income (AMI) is greater than 200% Federal Poverty Level (FPL) for one- to five-person households in each of Wisconsin's 72 counties. In households of 6+ members, 80% AMI is less than 200% FPL. Therefore, the state will allow categorical eligibility for WAP only for households with one to five members.

*** Per the State of Wisconsin's published WIC Income Eligibility Table, 80% AMI is greater than 185% FPL for all household sizes in every county in Wisconsin except the following: Ashland, Barron, Bayfield, Buffalo, Burnett, Clark, Crawford, Florence, Forest, Grant, Green Lake, Iron, Jackson, Juneau, Lafayette, Langlade, Marinette, Marquette, Menominee, Oconto, Polk, Price, Richland, Rusk, Sawyer, Shawano, Taylor, Vernon, Vilas, Washburn, Wood, Manitowoc, Oneida, Monroe, Pepin, Dodge, Lincoln, Rock, Trempealeau, Waupaca, Dunn, Sauk, Door.
