

## WHO CAN HELP YOU MAKE CHANGES?

Air sealing and insulation Trade Ally energy assessors are equipped with essential diagnostic tools and home analysis software. They will perform your Home Energy Assessment and, once complete, contact a Trade Ally contractor if necessary to guide you through your energy efficiency project by:

- ▶ Explaining the assessment process.
- ▶ Discussing your home concerns, such as drafts, mold or moisture buildup, ice dams, and high energy bills.
- ▶ Conducting a thorough interior and exterior inspection, checking for air and water leaks, insulation levels, HVAC equipment, appliance efficiency, and more.
- ▶ Performing combustion safety and blower door tests (infrared imaging is optional).
- ▶ Analyzing findings and presenting you with a customized energy report with energy- and money-saving recommendations.



After the assessment, your Trade Ally contractor will work with you to determine what upgrades you want to complete. Once you decide, your Trade Ally will help you **install the new equipment** and **apply for rebates** from Focus on Energy.
