BENEFITS

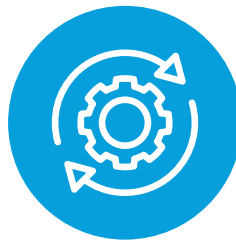
\$500 for each specific tune-up measure completed on your heating, cooling, or ventilation systems.



REBATES

OUTREACH - Contact your building controls Trade Ally.

TUNE-UP - Trade Ally completes building controls tune-up and submits application and documents.



PROCESS

1. Measures are implemented as identified (on-site).

2. Whole Building Tune-Up payment is sent within 4-6 weeks.



TIMELINE

MANAGE energy use more effectively.

IMPROVE indoor air quality and building occupant comfort.

DETECT small maintenance needs before they become costly repairs.

\$0.06 for completing the audit and reducing EUI by 1%.

\$0.01/ft² for every 1% EUI reduction over 1%.

Up to **\$100,000** per project.

START - Choose an RCx Service Provider (RSP) and complete the enrollment application.

AUDIT PHASE - Complete audit and submit estimated workbook, report, and invoice.

IMPLEMENTATION PHASE - Finalize RCx measures and submit final workbook documents.

1. Audit is completed within 6 months of enrollment approval.

2. Implementation is completed within 6 months of audit approval.

3. RCx payment is sent after verifying operational/system changes.
