This document contains talking points, best practices, and an email template to help schools contact solar tradespeople to set up a Solar Career Exploration Workshop. HOW TO GET STARTED

- Reach out to any solar industry professional you may know in the community.
- Contact the Chamber of Commerce in your city to see if any of the members are solar industry professionals.
- Google local solar professionals.

TALKING POINTS AND BEST PRACTICES

- Talking points that will resonate with solar tradespeople:
 - A Career Exploration Workshop is a great opportunity for solar companies to get involved in the community, speak to interested students, and potentially earn positive press in local publications.
 - FOCUS ON ENERGY[®] has developed a range of free workforce development supporting materials that are available for solar tradespeople.
- Start with an email and follow-up with a phone call.
- The best times to call are Tuesday—Thursday after 10:00 a.m.
- Make sure all parties are realistic about when the workshop can be scheduled.
 - Technology education class curriculums offer flexibility unlike core classes, but a workshop may not be able to be scheduled right away as technology education teachers will need to fit the workshop into an existing schedule.
